Tuesday, November 7th, 2017 @ 2:00pm

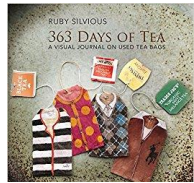

Saturday, November 11th, 2017 from 1:00pm - 3:00pm

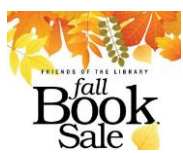
